Health Sciences Centre (HSC) Winnipeg

is the largest healthcare centre in Manitoba. We are an interdisciplinary team of nearly 8,000 staff and volunteers who serve people in Manitoba, northwestern Ontario and Nunavut.

HSC is the designated Trauma Centre for Manitoba, as well as the centre for transplants, burns, neurosciences and pediatric care. Our highly skilled teams provide comprehensive and specialized acute and continuing care to support the physical, medical and emotional needs of the people and communities we serve.

We also care for cancer patients with our partner, CancerCare Manitoba, located on the HSC campus.

HSC plays a special role in providing primary care for the community surrounding the hospital and in the core area of Winnipeg, as well as for Indigenous and Inuit peoples across Manitoba, northwestern Ontario and Nunavut. We also work with community agencies and health facilities inside and outside of Manitoba to provide several specialized province-wide programs unique to HSC. We are formally affiliated with University of Manitoba, whose students learn from us, and where many of our staff teach and do research.

HSC is accredited by the Canadian Council on Health Services Accreditation.

Critical Care: As Manitoba's trauma centre, HSC Winnipeg sees the sickest and most critically injured people in the province. We have four adult critical care units and a specialized unit for Ebola, burns, and other infectious diseases:

- Medical Intensive Care Unit
- Surgical Intensive Care Unit
- Intermediate Intensive Care Unit
- Cardiac Care Unit
- JK-3 Inpatient Unit (burns, Ebola)

These interdisciplinary environments are hubs of activity, where staff work closely with the Emergency department and other busy program areas, including Surgery and Medicine.
